Dear Neighbor,

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of utility work expected to begin on or around May 24, 2016 on Rochelle Ave and Central Ave in Rochelle Park.

To ensure the safety of the public and construction personnel, one lane of Rochelle Avenue between Central Ave and Railroad Ave will be closed during construction hours while critical utility work is completed. The closure is scheduled to begin on or about May 24th until June 15th. During this period, PSE&G will simultaneously begin road restoration on Rochelle Ave and Central Ave. Milling and paving will begin the week of June 6th and is scheduled to be completed by June 10th. Please note all work schedules are weather dependent.

Work will be completed between the hours of 7am-6pm. However, extended hours may be required during later stages of construction.

During this period you may experience traffic delays, however PSE&G will partner with the Rochelle Police Department to minimize inconvenience and explore all options to restoring the natural flow of traffic as safely as possible.

Local businesses will remain open during all construction and restoration activities.

Please adhere to the posted detour signage which will guide travelers to available access roads and also be aware that unpredictable field conditions may require periodic and unannounced changes. All changes will be made in conjunction with the Rochelle Park Police Department.

PSE&G apologizes for this inconvenience and we thank you for your understanding as we improve electric reliability for the region.
