

TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK

ORDINANCE NO. 1020-10

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VARIOUS CHAPTERS OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK
IN CONNECTION WITH MUNICIPAL FEES AND OTHER CHARGES**

WHEREAS, as a result of increases in the costs of performing certain services by the municipality it has become necessary to increase certain fees charged by the municipality for certain municipal services; and

WHEREAS, a review of these fees has revealed that they have not been reviewed or increased for many years; and

WHEREAS, the increases set forth herein are necessary and appropriate and are required in order to offset the costs associated with performing these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROCHELLE PARK, COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 88 of the Code of the Township of Rochelle Park entitled “Dogs” is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 88 -1(B) is hereby amended to raise the license and registration fee from \$5.80 to \$8.80.
2. Section 88-1(E) and (H) are hereby amended to delete the word “Registrar” and replace with “Municipal Clerk”

SECTION TWO: Chapter 58 of the Code of the Township of Rochelle Park entitled “Alcoholic Beverage Control” is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 58-1(A) is amended to increase the annual license fee for plenary retail consumption licenses from \$1,492.00 to \$1,790.00.

2. Section 58-1(B) is hereby amended to increase the annual license fee for plenary retail distribution licenses from \$995.00 to \$1,194.00.
3. Chapter 100 of the Code of the Township of Rochelle Park entitled “Fees and Licenses” is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 100-2 - ANNUAL FEES FOR LICENSES -

The annual fees for licensing of retail food establishments and other business subject to regulation by the Board of Health are hereby fixed as follows:

A. Restaurants, luncheonettes, etc.

SECTION 100-4 – FEES FOR BOARD OF HEALTH LICENSES & CERTICATES

The Board of Health fees shall be as follows:

A. Marriage license fee:	\$28.00
B. Copy of a marriage license:	\$10.00
C. Death certificates, each:	\$10.00
D. Birth certificates, each:	\$10.00
E. Civil Unions license:	\$28.00
F. Burial permit:	\$ 5.00

SECTION 100-4.1 - PUBLIC BATHING PLACES

The following fees shall be established for pubic bathing places:

A. Swimming pool and/or or whirlpool (year-round operation):	\$500.00
B. Swimming pool (seasonal):	\$250.00
C. Outdoor bathing place (seasonal):	\$250.00

SECTION THREE

Chapter 97of the Code of the Township of Rochelle Park entitled “EXCAVATION IN STREETS” is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 97-4 – AMOUNT OF DEPOSIT: PERFORMANCE BONDS

A. The permit deposit shall be in the following amounts for each opening or excavation covered by such permit:

- (1) For unimproved streets or places from \$40.00 to \$100.00
- (2) For streets or places with macadam surfaces: from \$75.00 to \$100.00 for 22 linear feet and \$10 for each additional foot
- (3) For street or places with concrete surfaces: from \$100.00 to \$400.00 for 22 linear feet and \$10 for each additional foot

SECTION FOUR. Repealer:

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION FIVE: Severability:

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effects to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION SIX: Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication and in the manner provided by law.
