Cell Phone/Electronics Policy

Camp is a **cell-phone** and **electronic free zone**. If cell phones come to camp, they must remain safely in a backpack or held for safekeeping at the camp office. If a camper needs to contact home, they can use our landline in our recreation office. Remember the RPDC is not responsible for the loss or damage of any personal item. Pictures are not to be taken with a cellphone. Pictures can be taken with a digital camera, and or a disposable camera that can be reviewed by the parent first before it can be uploaded to any internet source.

Our Electronics Policy is designed to:

- Encourage your children to spend more time in the outdoors
- Promote socialization between campers
- Reduce the stress associated with the damage to and theft of electronics
- Give your children a much needed break from the world of technology
- Allow your children to fully embrace and “plug into” the connections they make with other campers as they “unplug” from their electronics
- Ensure that your children are not exposed to age-inappropriate material
- Ensure that your children cannot post their camp photos on the internet without other parental permission.
- Ensure that your children are not focusing on situations that could lead to bullying online.
